During my studies, I completed an internship and master's thesis at KWR Water Research Institute in Nieuwegein, the Netherlands. My thesis focused on modeling the fate and transport of fecal pathogens at drinking water intake locations along the River Maas. Prior to that, during my internship at KWR as part of the EU PathoCERT project, I worked on developing fine-tuning datasets to assess the ability of large language models (LLMs) in information extraction about pathogen contamination events in drinking water networks.
